

Mosquito Valley. South Patagonia .

25 kilometers north from el Chalten we arrive to el Mosquito river, this river runs from loma del Diablo. This valley provides very good ski touring options from easy to difficult options with nice view from Fitz Roy range.

Difficulty: Easy / Medium.

Duration: 1 day.

Pax: 1 to 4 persons.

Recommended month: July to October.

Included: UIAGM/IFMGA mountain guide, technical equipment, GPS, communication: VHF and satellite comunicación, safety gear (beacon, shovel, probe)

Not included: skis, boots.



Program: the day before the expedition there's a brief meeting with the guide to check equipment and arrange last-minute details.

Day 1: Early in the morning we drive 45 minutes to the parking area close to Mosquito river. The first 300 meters of elevation we will follow a trail quite steep till we get to the end of the vegetation. Depending on the time of the year from there we will continue with the skis until we get to a flat area call "Teta". From there we will have the option to go to the North face, South face or East to the main summit.

Duration: 8 - 10 hs

Elevation gain: 1500 meters
